We have made some exciting changes to our staff structure this year to align our talents with our ever evolving community's needs! With our local businesses still recovering from the effects of the pandemic, Borough Council had asked us to accept a reduction in funding for this past year. That, combined with a loss of rental income from our Community Room and Bookstore revenue added up to an operating budget 30% smaller than in years past. The result has been a reduction in open hours and staffing. Sadly, this trend promises to continue into next year.

Fortunately, our vibrant Friends of the Jenkintown Library have been actively entertaining us all year with a garden tour and Children's Summer Reading Challenge, supporting local businesses with olive oil and tequila tastings, and providing ways to safely gather with their 2nd Annual Dinner en Blanc et Noir. They have raised necessary funds that help keep our doors open and lights on.

We also hope that we can count on your continued support as we pivot and grow, preserving all that is charming and beloved about our Library while ensuring we meet the specific needs of this community.
